Dear Secretary Dortch:

The North American Portability Management LLC (the "NAPM LLC"), by its attorneys, hereby files a written summary of the NAPM LLC's status updates to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") regarding the transition from the current local number portability administrator ("LNPA"), Neustar, to the new LNPA, Telcordia d/b/a iconectiv (the "Report"). This Report updates the FCC, the public, and all interested stakeholders regarding transition activities to date in accordance with the requirements of the LNPA Selection Order<sup>1</sup> and guidance received from the FCC on Wednesday, June 24, 2015. The NAPM LLC will file written updates of this Report with the FCC at the end of each month, beginning July 31, 2015.

### **Transition Oversight Plan**

The latest version of the Transition Oversight Plan (TOP), dated August 31, 2015, is published on the public portion of the NAPM LLC's website at [www.NAPMLLC.org](http://www.NAPMLLC.org).

### **Stakeholder Outreach and Education**

As discussed in the September 2015 Report, a Transition Outreach and Education Plan ("TOEP") was developed and finalized with the oversight of the FCC, and is included as an Exhibit in the amended TOP filed on August 31, 2015. On October 29, 2015, the NAPM LLC filed an updated TOEP with the FCC. By Public Notice dated November 25, 2015 (DA 15-1367), the Wireline Competition Bureau of the FCC approved the revised Transition Plan and announced the first transition outreach webcast.

### **Transition Oversight Manager**

The TOM continued to advance the objectives of the LNPA transition program in November. The relevant accomplishments include:

- Established date for first LNPA Transition Outreach (LTO) webcast: 12/9/15 3:00PM-4:00PM EST; interested parties can register at <https://event.webcasts.com/starthere.jsp?ei=1084375> and developed corresponding presentation;
- Secured approval by all parties of the NPAC data exchange file format specification;



- Completed review of the draft project plan checkpoint dates and dependencies for all transition work streams; and
- Revised the LNPA transition Dispute Resolution Framework, incorporating NAPM LLC feedback

The TOM conducts weekly meetings with the NAPM LLC Transition Team, iconectiv and Neustar to coordinate activities and communication among the parties and address ad hoc issues as they arise. These working meetings are used to identify, discuss and close tasks (A.K.A. action items) required to advance the project objectives. The graph below depicts the progress achieved in addressing these action items since the last monthly report.

The TOM continued to track identified transition risks including:

- Dates for key milestones; and
- Agreement on key transition requirements.

### **Negotiations With iconectiv**

The NAPM LLC and iconectiv began negotiating the new LNPA contract on May 21, 2015. The Master Services Agreement was conditionally approved by the NAPM LLC on October 26, 2015.

### **Negotiations With Neustar**


A Transition Services agreement will address any additional services above and beyond the standard LNPA services provided by Neustar today that are necessary to facilitate a successful transition to the new LNPA.
