

Comments for Proceeding Number: 15-149.

With six Companies controlling 90% of our Public Media, the FCC should not allow for any more mergers of this type.

For the last three years, to obtain News happening in my own Country, I have to rely on foreign News sources such as RT.com and Israel Business News, because those News sources report the News which our US News media does not.

About a year ago I learned of the One America News Network, more commonly known as OANN, and I was surprised to see that OANN reports on much of the News I do not see on the Larger Networks, limiting my need to read and listen to foreign News sources to learn about the News occurring in my own Country. I watch or read OANN daily, about 30-45 minutes a day.

The FCC's past decisions to allow for mega-mergers, which essentially created a Media Cartel in our Country, inhibits information from being reported in the mainstream News. I am sure this is not what FCC's intentions were when approving past mergers, but it is the result, and I ask that all future decisions to approve Media Mergers takes into consideration the impact it will have on the average person, and not only a Mega-Corporations bottom line.

I hope my bringing this to your Attention limits this present and future Media Merger, and convinces your Office to protect Independent News sources from being pushed off our TV Airways.
