Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 64.606(f)(2), Sorenson Communications, Inc., (“Sorenson”) hereby notifies the Commission of a substantive change to its TRS service. On or about December 3, 2015, Sorenson permanently discontinued its legacy VP-200 videophones. After that date, VP-200 videophones are no longer operative. Sorenson expects that this change will only affect a small number of individuals. All current VP-200 users are eligible for an upgrade and Sorenson has made numerous efforts to contact those users and transition them without interrupting their service. Any remaining users who have not upgraded may do so by contacting Sorenson.
