Dear Ms. Dortch:

I write to follow up on my correspondence to you, dated November 24, 2015, regarding the appointment of Susan L. Uecker to serve as receiver in the case of *Arnold Leong v. Warren Havens, et al.*, in the Superior Court of California, County of Alameda.

As I explained in my earlier correspondence, Ms. Uecker is required to take control of the assets of several entities, some of which are FCC licensees: Verde Systems LLC; Telesaurus Holdings GB LLC; Environmental LLC; Environmental-2 LLC; Intelligent Transportation & Monitoring Wireless LLC; Skybridge Spectrum Foundation; V2G LLC; as well as any FCC licenses owned or controlled by Warren Havens as an individual<sup>1</sup> (together, the "Receivership Entities").

The Receivership Entities have been active participants in the above-referenced proceeding. In my prior correspondence, Ms. Uecker sought an extension of time to respond, on behalf of the Receivership Entities, to Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC's ("MCLM's") and Choctaw Holdings, LLC's ("Choctaw's") respective motions to supplement their petitions for reconsideration of the Commission's order denying their requests for reconsideration of granting *Second Thursday* relief in the above-referenced proceeding.

The Receivership Entities' position regarding MCLM's and Choctaw's pending motions has been adequately articulated in the Opposition to Petitions for Reconsideration that the Receivership Entities filed with the Commission on October 24, 2014. Accordingly, Ms. Uecker
