The merger should be challenged under the terms of the 1996 Telecommunications Act, but if that does not happen, then, at a minimum, fledgling news organizations such as OANN should be guaranteed fair and equal access to the news consuming public served by the merging entities as an absolute condition of any approval by the FCC of this ill-advised and open threat to the competitive market conditions.
