On Tuesday, December 8, 2015, Walter McCormick, Lynn Follansbee and I met with Commissioner Pai and his Legal Advisor Nick Degani concerning USTelecom's Petition for Forbearance. We discussed the drag that the legacy obligations identified in the petition impose on the ability of incumbent LECs to invest in new and upgraded broadband networks that consumers and businesses want. We explained that removing these obligations would allow incumbent LECs to better compete with cable and other networks and that this stronger competition would serve consumers and the public interest.
