Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules to notify the Commission that today, the undersigned, counsel for the Wireless Communications Association International ("WCA"), together with Richard Engelman and Gardner Foster of Sprint Corporation met with Edward Smith, Legal Advisor to Chairman Tom Wheeler. During the course of the meeting we discussed the concerns of the Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") and Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") community regarding interference from Globalstar's proposal to deploy Terrestrial Low Power Service ("TLPS") in the spectrum immediately adjacent to the BRS/EBS allocation.

We reiterated, as WCA has stressed in formal pleadings and recent prior ex parte filings,¹ that Globalstar has failed to address serious unanswered questions as to how its proposed TLPS will meet Globalstar's absolute obligation to protect adjacent licensed BRS and EBS operations from harmful interference. We stressed that until those concerns are addressed, the Commission should refrain from modifying its Ancillary Terrestrial Component rules or otherwise authorizing Globalstar to provide a TLPS over its 2483.5-2495 MHz Mobile Satellite Service spectrum.
