Pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Commission's Second Protective Order in the above-referenced proceedings, Convo Communications, LLC ("Convo") submits two copies of the attached REDACTED – FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION version of the December 23, 2015 Convo *Ex Parte* redacting the company-sensitive proprietary information the Commission requested from small providers regarding the compensation of their executives.

The Commission staff made a preliminary determination that Convo's detailed information about its executive compensation met the requirements set forth in the Second Protective Order to be designated as Highly Confidential. A copy of the December 23, 2015 Convo *Ex Parte* stamped as a Highly Confidential Document has been sent under separate cover.

Convo's *ex parte* presentation constitutes highly sensitive commercial information that falls within Exemption 4 of the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"). Consequently, Convo requests that this material be withheld from public inspection.
