Dear Secretary Dortch:

Please accept this amendment to the Region 5 700 MHz allocation spreadsheet for approval, that deletes allotments to Los Angeles Metropolitan Transit Agency (MTA) and adds allotments to County of Riverside.

The Region 5 chair recently contacted MTA concerning their allotments because the MTA has not filed applications to license the channels. The MTA has had this allotment since the original plan approval. The chair received back an email indicating MTA did not need the 700 MHz allotments (see attached email). By removing MTA allotments this frees up channels for a long standing request by Riverside County for additional channels that can be used in the west half of the County to expand capacity in their existing system. Riverside states they are adding additional cities to their system in that area.

Also attached is the proposed new spreadsheet showing these changes in red font with MTA deletions shown with strike through red font. After FCC approval the spreadsheet will be updated to remove MTA allotments.

The west half of Riverside County is more than 70 miles from the nearest adjacent region, so adjacent region concurrence is not required. A new note 3 was added to reflect use in the west half of the county.
