

The FEMA Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS) Program Management Office compiled the following usage statistics regarding Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEAs) processed through IPAWS and passed on the cellular service providers for public distribution. Alert totals represent alerts issued since WEA became operational in April, 2012.

As of January 6, 2016:

- 622 **state and local** organizations have permission to send WEA
- 48 **state and local** organizations have sent WEA alerts
- Collectively, these **state and local** organizations have sent a total of 299 WEA alerts
- NOAA has sent 21,357 WEA alerts
- NCMEC has sent 589 WEA alerts

As of November 18, 2015:

- 608 **state and local** organizations have permission to send WEA
- 46 **state and local** organizations have sent WEA alerts
- Collectively, these **state and local** organizations have sent a total of 248 WEA alerts
- NOAA has sent 20,262 WEA alerts
- NCMEC has sent 566 WEA alerts

As of June 2, 2015:

- 576 **state and local** organizations have permission to send WEA
- 34 **state and local** organizations have sent WEA alerts
- Collectively, these **state and local** organizations have sent a total of 173 WEA alerts
- NOAA has sent about 20,000 WEA alerts
- NCMEC has sent about 500 WEA alerts
