On January 6, 2016, Ericsson's CEO, Hans Vestberg, President and CEO of Ericsson's Region North America, Angel Ruiz, and the Head of Corporate Affairs and Communications for Ericsson North America, Barbara Baffer, met with Chairman Tom Wheeler and Stephanie Weiner, the Chairman's Senior Legal Advisor, Wireline.

At the meeting, Mr. Vestberg stressed that with demand for mobile broadband continuing to grow, new technology, carrier aggregation, and more spectrum are needed to meet customers' needs. Chairman Wheeler and Mr. Vestberg discussed the need for the U.S. to lead in 5G research and development, and that Ericsson is supporting its customers with 5G test beds. Mr. Vestberg also assured Chairman Wheeler that Ericsson supports unlicensed and licensed technologies across various frequency bands.
