Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 5, 2016, Ericsson's CEO, Hans Vestberg, and the Head of Corporate Affairs and Communications for Ericsson North America, Barbara Baffer, met with Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel and Travis Litman, the Commissioner's Senior Legal Advisor.

Mr. Vestberg suggested that the U.S. should build on the success of 4G LTE deployment by ensuring adequate spectrum and a flexible environment for new 5G services. For example, in the near term, Mr. Vestberg asked the FCC to consider a 5G testbed and to offer increased flexibility for 5G services. Mr. Vestberg noted that spectrum aggregation will be increasingly important to solve ever increasing data usage. He also stated that Ericsson is committed to continuing to support technologies in licensed and unlicensed spectrum across multiple bands.
