**ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S REQUESTED ISSUES  
PURSUANT TO ORDER, FCC 16M-1**

Pursuant to Section 1.229 of the Commission's rules,<sup>1</sup> the Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) sought the addition of issues to the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>2</sup> On January 12, 2016, the Presiding Judge granted the Bureau's motion to enlarge the issues and instructed the Bureau to submit its requested issues in the appropriate format.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, the Bureau sets forth below ordering clauses addressing the newly-added issues that should now be considered part of this proceeding, numbered as additional ordering clauses Nos. 1-6:

**ADDITIONAL ORDERING CLAUSES**

1. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William L. Zawila IS DIRECTED TO SHOW that he was an owner, officer, or individual who controlled the operations of Avenal Educational Services, Inc. and was authorized to serve as counsel for, or otherwise represent, Avenal Educational Services, Inc. during the time periods referenced in the Order To Show Cause, Notice of Opportunity For Hearing, and Hearing Designation Order (HDO)<sup>4</sup> and at all times thereafter.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William L. Zawila IS DIRECTED TO SHOW that he was an owner, officer, or individual who controlled the operations of Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. and was authorized to serve as counsel for, or otherwise represent, Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. during the time periods referenced in the HDO and at all times thereafter.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Avenal Educational Services, Inc. IS DIRECTED TO SHOW who was an owner, officer, or individual who controlled the operations of Avenal Educational Services, Inc. and who was authorized to serve as counsel for, or otherwise represent, Avenal Educational Services, Inc. during the time periods referenced in the HDO and at all times thereafter.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. IS DIRECTED TO SHOW who was an owner, officer, or individual who controlled the operations

of Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. and who was authorized to serve as counsel for, or otherwise represent, Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. during the time periods referenced in the HDO and at all times thereafter.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Sections 312(a) and 312(c) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>5</sup> William L. Zawila, Avenal Educational Services, Inc. and Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. ARE DIRECTED TO SHOW CAUSE why the construction permits for Stations KAAX (FM) and KYAF (FM) (formerly KAJP (FM)) should not be REVOKED and all authority to operate said stations TERMINATED, and the pending applications for licenses to cover these permits DISMISSED, at a hearing before the Presiding Judge at a time and place to be specified in a subsequent Order, upon the following issues:

- (a) To determine whether William L. Zawila misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission in the applications for the construction permits for Stations KAAX (FM) and/or KYAF (FM);
- (b) To determine whether William L. Zawila at any time misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission concerning the corporate status of Avenal Educational Services, Inc.;
- (c) To determine whether William L. Zawila at any time misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission concerning the corporate status of Central Valley Educational Services, Inc.;
- (d) To determine whether Avenal Educational Services, Inc. was a qualified applicant pursuant to Section 73.503(a) of the Commission's rules at the time it filed its application for the construction permit for Station KAAX (FM);
- (e) To determine whether Avenal Educational Services, Inc. misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission in its application for the construction permit for Station KAAX (FM);
- (f) To determine whether Avenal Educational Services, Inc. at any time misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission concerning its corporate status;
- (g) To determine whether Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. was a qualified applicant pursuant to Section 73.503(a) of the Commission's rules at the time it filed its application for the construction permit for Station KYAF (FM);
- (h) To determine whether Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission in its application for the construction permit for Station KYAF (FM);
- (i) To determine whether Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. at any time misrepresented facts to and/or lacked candor with the Commission concerning its

corporate status; and

- (j) To determine, in light of the evidence adduced under the foregoing issues, whether William L. Zawila, Avenal Educational Services, Inc., and/or Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. possess the requisite qualifications to be and remain Commission permittees and/or licensees.

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that it shall be determined, pursuant to Section 503(b)(3)(A) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>6</sup> and Section 1.80 of the Commission's rules, whether an Order of Forfeiture in an amount not to exceed the statutory limit shall be issued against William L. Zawila, Avenal Educational Services, Inc., and/or Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. for willfully and/or repeatedly violating Section 73.503(a) of the Commission's rules.


