Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules to report that on January 13, 2016, Ed Lavergne and Donna Balaguer (representing the Catholic Technology Network and the National EBS Association), and Gardner Foster, James Goldstein, and Richard Engelman (representing Sprint Corporation) met with Jean Kiddoo, of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Blaise Scinto, John Schauble and Nancy Zaczek of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's Broadband Division, regarding the above referenced proceeding. Sprint expressed its support for the Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") consensus licensing proposal submitted to the Commission on June 6, 2014 in WT Docket No. 03-66 as the most reasonable and timely way to permanently license all remaining unlicensed EBS spectrum in the United States. The parties urged the Commission move forward with a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to implement the consensus licensing proposal. To the extent that any other EBS rule changes are under consideration, the parties urged that such issues be addressed separately in the future so as not to unduly delay nationwide licensing of EBS spectrum.
