Schools and Libraries Program: CC Docket No. 02-6

This is an appeal of the USAC Administrator's Decision on Appeal, dated 11/25/2015 for funding request number 2670054 (ref: the decision of the Form 472 (BEAR) Notification Letter dated August 19, 2015 – USAC invoice number 2207315 - SPIN number 143031963.) Please find several supporting documents attached, along with this letter.

The USAC decision letter states the appeal was dismissed, as we still have time to submit an invoice for the amount paid G4. However, G4 was purchased by Segtel –wholly absorbed, and no longer exists, Bruce, from Segtel, informed me there is no way for anyone to certify a BEAR using this SPIN or FRN. And, since USAC denied our request to submit an invoice for the G4 portion of the funding commitment under Segtel's SPIN, we have no way to apply for the balance. Any invoice we would submit cannot be certified.

After multiple attempts to find a resolution (case #22-638933, 22-768564, 22-768603) A USAC representative (case #22-698453) stated, we needed to file an "Operational SPIN Change." We did. That was bad advice. Segtel should have filed a "Global SPIN Change." after the merger. We cannot file a Global SPIN Change on their behalf. Another representative (EPC #9027) said our only recourse would be to file an appeal to USAC. We did. It was dismissed. Today, a representative (case #40215) suggested I file an appeal to the FCC. This is that appeal.

According the original funding notification letter, we are still owed a balance of \$251.79, which is the portion of the funding year paid to G4.

I appreciate your attention to this matter. It is unfair to penalize us for the inaction of our ISP, and bad advice from a USAC representative.
