**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR
RECONSIDERATION**

MTA Communications, LLC d/b/a MTA Wireless/Matanuska-Kenai, Inc. (“MTAC”), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.106(f), hereby requests leave to file a supplement to its December 15, 2015 Petition for Reconsideration (“Petition”) to the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) and Wireline Competition Bureau (“Bureau”). MTAC spent significant time and resources attempting to determine the underlying cause of this issue, and only fully discovered the full facts after the 30-day deadline to file a supplement to its Petition.

Section 1.106(f) provides that the Commission may grant leave to file a supplement to a petition for reconsideration upon a separate pleading for leave to file which states the grounds therefor. In this instance, the Supplement to Petition for Reconsideration and Waiver (“Supplement”) which MTAC seeks leave to file discusses in detail MTA’s revised understanding of how the data did not reach USAC as expected. MTAC continued to investigate the circumstances surrounding its Form 525 filing well after it filed its December 15 Petition. It

was not until MTAC filed its quarterly Form 525 on December 28 that the issue became clear. MTAC filed its Supplement on December 29, but failed to file the required motion for leave required by 47 C.F.R. § 1.106(f) because the filing was one day beyond the 30 day deadline. MTAC seeks to remedy that oversight by filing this Petition. Acceptance of the Supplement will assist the Commission and Bureau by allowing the record to reflect a full recitation of the facts. Because the Bureau has not yet acted on MTAC's Petition for Reconsideration, acceptance and consideration of this Supplement will not delay the proceeding.

Based on the foregoing, MTAC requests that the Commission grant this Petition for Leave to File Supplement and accept the accompanying Supplement for the record in this proceeding.
