**COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF REQUEST**

COMES NOW the undersigned, JAMES E. WHEDBEE, in support of SENSIFREE's request for waiver, commenting as follows.

1.)       SENSIFREE's request has shown good cause in that the technical details comport with the spirit, if not the intent, of existing Commission rules and regulations. Moreover, SENSIFREE's request points to the need for the Commission to revisit those same UWB regulations as it promised to do some many years ago. At the power levels of these devices, the continuous sprawl of waiver requests points to glaring flaws in the status quo and a need for reform consistent with extant technological developments.

2.)       A logical outgrowth of this waiver proceeding would be process reform aimed, inter alia, at giving new and rapidly developing technologies a better regulatory schema.

3.)       However, a delay in SENSIFREE's request to address that logical outgrowth would be unfair; therefore, the undersigned strongly recommends the Commission grant, without delay and without condition, SENSIFREE's waiver request and proceed separately onto adoption of process reforms intended at curing the needs inuring from the existing manner of doing business via waivers.

4.)       A Petition for Rulemaking has been filed by the undersigned, separately, to address process reform.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned prays for the immediate and unconditional grant of SENSIFREE's waiver request.
