Dear Chairman Wheeler,

I am in support of Charter Communication's proposed merger with Time Warner Cable (TWC) and the acquisition of Bright House Networks (BHN) relating to Proceeding Number 15-149.

Charter Communications has provided cable services to our property owners in Bridgeport Charter Township for many years.

The proposed merger will result in the creation of "New Charter" which has made commitments to expand availability of services to include providing superior broadband service to underserved families and seniors. I understand this will become available within six months of the closing of the transactions and the offer will be fully implemented across Charter's footprint within three years of closing.

I also understand with this merger you have already brought back jobs from overseas call centers and hired thousands of people to improve our customer care services. Along with that I understand you will also, as the "New Charter", return TWC call center jobs to the United States and will hire and train thousands of new employees for its customer service call centers and field technician operations.

I also understand that "New Charter" is making legally enforceable commitments that put consumers first. Consisting of: free and open internet, engage in reasonable and non-discriminatory interconnection, continue to create thousands of U.S. based jobs, will make comprehensive and significant investments in its broad band network, broaden access to broadband, promote diversity and inclusion strongly rooted in the communities it serves, invest significantly in both in-home and out-of-home Wi-Fi, build out one million line extensions on our networks improving service to rural and other underserved areas, and build-out of networks into commercial areas.

With that said, we in Bridgeport Charter Township ask the FCC to grant approval for this merger.
