**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to Section 1.46(b) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. 1.46 (2015), the Wright Petitioners request additional time to respond to the Petition for Stay Pending Judicial Review, filed by CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc. (CenturyLink). Although the Petition carries a date of January 22, 2016, it was not made available to the public through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) until January 27, 2016.

Specifically, ECFS indicates that the Petition was not received until January 27, 2016, and was not posted until January 27, 2016:

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However, the Petition is dated January 22, 2016, and it is not clear whether the applicable opposition deadline pursuant to Section 1.45(d) is: (i) January 29, 2016, i.e., seven days after January 22, 2016 (the date appearing in the Petition), or (ii) February 3, 2016, i.e., seven days after January 27, 2016 (the date the FCC indicates the Petition was filed).

Further complicating the matter, CenturyLink filed a public copy through ECFS which had been substantially redacted. Undersigned counsel has requested a copy of the confidential version of the Petition, but has not yet received it. Because many of CenturyLink's arguments supporting its Petition are based on the redacted information, additional time is necessary to review and, if necessary, respond to the Petition.

In light of these considerations, good cause exists for the FCC to grant this motion and establish February 3, 2016, as the deadline for responding to CenturyLink's Petition.
