*Re: Application of Charter Communications, Inc., Time Warner Cable Inc., and Advance/Newhouse Partnership For Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses and Authorizations, MB Docket No. 15-149.*

On January 28, 2016, Corie Wright and Josh Korn of Netflix met with Owen Kendler, Kiley Naas, Jim Bird, and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel; Betsy McIntyre, Mike Ray, David Brody, John Castle, Adam Copeland, and Tavi Carare of the Wireline Competition Bureau; and Susan Singer and Brendan Holland of the Media Bureau.

In the meeting, Netflix reiterated its support for Charter Communication Inc.'s interconnection policy, implemented in July 2015<sup>1</sup> and Charter's commitment to extend this policy to the Time Warner Cable and Bright House Network footprints as an enforceable condition.

Charter's interconnection policy is a welcome departure from the efforts of some ISPs -- including Time Warner Cable -- to collect access tolls on the Internet. The application of this policy across the "New Charter" footprint promotes the public interest through efficient interconnection with online content providers and with the transit and content delivery services that smaller online content providers rely on to deliver their content to consumers.

We explained that an enforceable and long-standing condition will support growing demand for online services and ensure that consumers across the entire "New Charter" footprint receive the fast connection speeds they pay for.
