Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Monday, February 1, 2016 the undersigned and Richard Gibbs, counsel for Tampnet Inc. (“Tampnet”), met with Commission staff from the International Bureau, Wireless Bureau and the Office of the General Counsel to discuss certain issues raised in this proceeding. Attending this meeting for the Commission were the following persons: Susan O’Connell, David Krech, Kimberly Cook and Clay DeCell from the International Bureau; Kathy Harris and Scott Patrick from the Wireless Bureau; and Neil Dellar from the Office of the General Counsel.

During the meeting counsel for Tampnet provided further background on Tampnet’s current and planned future operations, and the operations of its parent company Tampnet AS. We also discussed the public interest benefits of the transaction at issue in the above-referenced applications, and the competitive dynamics of the market in which Tampnet intends to compete. In addition, counsel for Tampnet discussed certain disclosures made in Tampnet’s pending Petition for Declaratory Ruling and the potential for additional disclosures of individuals and entities with interests in Tampnet. Copies of draft revisions to the ownership structure, as well as public information concerning certain interest holders, was provided to Commission staff attending the meeting. Copies of these materials are attached to this notice.

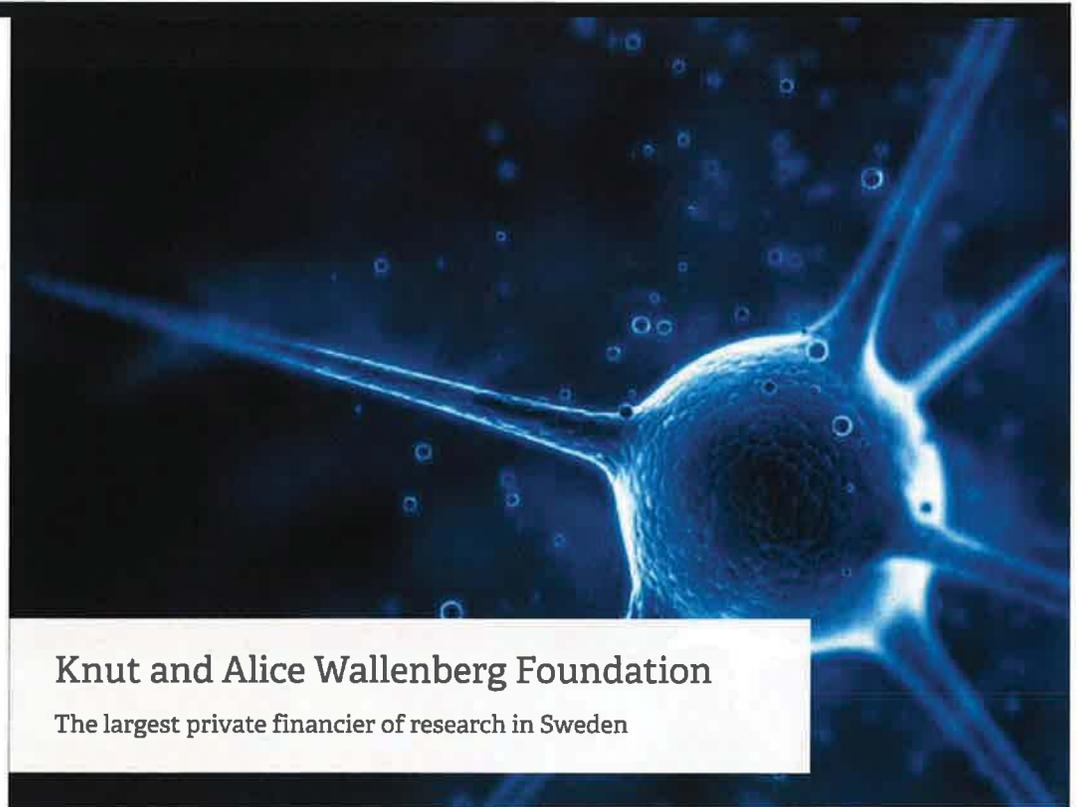

Review

All applications to the Foundation must go through the Universities internal prioritization process. Applications submitted to the Foundation will be exposed to an extensive international peer-review procedure.

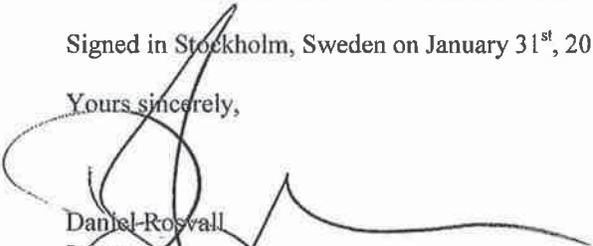
Declares:
