Dear Ms. Dortch,

On February 4, 2016, Joan Marsh and the undersigned of AT&T met with Roger Sherman, Brian Reagan, Jean Kiddo, Roger Noel and Linda Chang of the Wireless Bureau. At the meeting, AT&T reviewed the history of the Wireless Communications Services (WCS) band and in particular the limitations placed on the WCS C and D blocks to prevent interference to the neighboring SDARS bands. We then updated staff on deployments to date and plans for continued expansion of service in the WCS spectrum. The attached band plan illustration was used to facilitate that discussion.

Separately, on February 5, Joan Marsh met with Commissioner Rosenworcel and her legal advisor Johanna Thomas to review service rules in the WCS band and provide an update on plans for continued expansion of service in the band.



WCS Band



- Long history of disputes in the band have been largely resolved
- C and D Blocks remain encumbered by strict limitations necessary to protect SDARS and AMT services
 - No mobile use permitted in the C Block
 - Tight limitations on EIRP / low TX power
 - Stepped emissions mask for OOB
- Coordination challenges in these blocks severe given proximity to SDARS services
