On February 8, 2016, Tom Harper and David Brunt of Chester Telephone Company dba TruVista (“Chester”) and John Kuykendall and Cassandra Heyne of JSI met via conference call with Amy Bender from Commissioner Michael O’Rielly’s office. The subject of discussion was Chester Telephone Company’s January 11, 2016 letter to the Federal Communications Commission and Wireline Competition Bureau regarding Chester’s FCC Form 477 data and the Alternative Connect America Model (“A-CAM”). Chester recently revised its Form 477 data after reviewing the illustrative results of the A-CAM version 2.1 and realizing that it had incorrectly reported fiber-to-the-home deployment in 706 census blocks where fiber was not actually deployed. Chester expeditiously corrected its previous two Form 477 filings and is requesting that the Commission incorporate its revised, accurate data in the forthcoming final version of the A-CAM. Chester is seeking assurance from Commission staff that the correct data will be used in the A-CAM.
