

Since the advent of improved, enhanced closed captioning in devices(cable box; cc converter boxes and TV's) it is my opinion that it is no longer necessary to force CC build-ins in cable boxes as today's Television manufacturers have an incredible array of CC configurations built into all TV sets. There is so much more one can choose in regard to choice of CC from Television than what was forced to include in CC cable boxes. Most cable boxes if not all have but 2 selections namely: black background; or yellow transparent captions, that's it. While TV's have: same as mentioned before but include larger fonts(for the visually impaired); captions can be moved anywhere in the screen so as not to impede commercials or instant headlines; transparent CC viewing; colors; underlinings, etc. It seems to be imperative to relieve cable box providers of the need to implement or force them to include CC's, but just use the TV's CC's. **By using cable boxes**..the advantage of TV's incredible array of CC's are **blacked out**.

All in all I prefer to use the Television manufacturer's choice of CC set-up over the mediocre set-up by cable box providers.
