Chairman Wheeler,

I'm writing to urge you to restore broadband competition by fixing the broken market for high-capacity broadband lines. The FCC must address anti-competitive behavior in this market to reach its goal of delivering better, faster, cheaper broadband to all Americans. The future of our information economy depends on it. I had FreedomPop for more than a year. The cost of 10GB a month for FreedomPop was only \$23 until last fall when it phased out its WiMax service and switched to LTE and raised its monthly rate to \$74 for 10GB. This increase is so outrageous that I switched over to AT&T U-verse which is only \$25 a month for a full year. What FreedomPop did isn't fair! NetZero did the same thing. It too phased out its WiMax service and switched to LTE and raised its monthly rates just that much. Something needs to be done!
