Re: *Connect America Fund, WC Docket No. 10-90*; Rule 54.312 Notification

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. ("PRT") hereby files this letter to notify the Commission, pursuant to Section 54.312 of the Commission's rules¹ that PRT proposes to modify its Connect America Fund ("CAF") Phase I Round 2 broadband deployment plan.

PRT accepted CAF Phase I Round 2 support on August 23, 2013.² Along with its acceptance letter, PRT identified 40,736 locations where it intended to deploy 4/1 Mbps broadband.³

PRT now intends to modify its broadband deployment plan to serve previously unidentified unserved locations. Thus, pursuant to Section 54.312 of the


