To Whom it may concern, After reading Mr. Krotz's proposal, I disagree with this petition.

There is no administrative benefit to the FCC of having a lifetime amateur radio license unless

the vanity call sign system is rescinded and done away with.

Commercial radio operator licenses can not be changed by request and therefore requires less

administrative overhead. The change to the general radio operators license (GROL) to grant for

the life of the owner has no bearing as a reference for petition RM-11760.

Under the current vanity call system, if a amateur radio operator becomes deceased or is no longer

interested in radio operation, the call sign database would become excessively inaccurate.

This would increase problems with the FCC having correct licensee contact information as well as

leaving many call signs unavailable for the Commission's reuse or for the vanity system.

Pursuant to Section 1.41 of the Commission's rules and regulations, I request the Commission immediately deny Mr. Krotz's

request.
