As the CEO of the Garland Chamber of Commerce, I am writing to support the merger between Charter Communications, Time Warner Cable, and Bright House Networks.

As part of a Chamber that works toward the common goals of the Garland citizens I am in favor of New Charter. I believe the merger would benefit the community through its commitment to invest in more commercial areas and expand access to broadband to low-income consumers.

Garland Chamber is interested in Charter's commitment to invest more in commercial areas. This commitment will help the Garland Chamber of Commerce as we work to recruit new business, retain existing business and ensure the Garland economy continues to grow. After the merger, New Charter will invest at least \$2.5 billion in the build-out of networks into commercial areas within its footprint beyond where it currently operates. This will create additional, much-needed competition in the commercial sector.

Additionally, the Garland Chamber of Commerce is interested in Charter's plans to expand Bright House Networks' low-income broadband program.
