Dear Chairman Wheeler,

I have the honor of serving in the Texas House and representing my constituents in Southeast Texas. Time Warner Cable currently provides service to part of my district and I am writing to respectfully encourage the FCC to approve the Charter Communications, Time Warner Cable, and Bright House Networks merger. I expect the merged companies to invest more in broadband services and innovative video products.

Charter has committed to make significant broadband investments that would improve and expand the broadband capabilities in Time Warner Cable's current footprint. The company plans to deliver fiber-optics to more resident and businesses. Charter also plans to increase broadband speeds and introduce a new 60 Mbps entry-level speed for residential customers.

Additionally, the company plans to invest more to improve the customer care experience. Charter plans to hire and train more field technician operators. I also welcome Charter's plans to bring back more jobs from overseas and hiring more call center employees in the U.S. Charter has already implemented similar initiatives over the last three years with great success in creating new jobs.

I have heard concerns from constituents who do not have access to adequate broadband service and I believe the combination of Charter, Time Warner Cable, and Bright House Networks will benefit the area I represent and I urge the Commission to approve the merger.
