During the meeting, representatives for the Applicants discussed the substantial public interest benefits the transaction will deliver to consumers. We also discussed New Charter’s commitments, including providing settlement-free interconnection under its interconnection policy, broadband service without usage-based billing or data caps, and high-value broadband for eligible low income households and seniors.
