ADDITIONAL DECLARATORY RULING REQUESTS
Based Upon the Evidence Submitted within FCC Case ID 06-210

In addition to the 2006 referral from Judge Bassler and the additional declaratory ruling requests already submitted by petitioners. Petitioners wish the FCC to also consider the following additional declaratory ruling requests as it relates to the CCI to PSE transaction.

- 1) Decide at the time of the attempted Jan 13th 1995, CCI to PSE traffic only (i.e. locations only transfer without CCI's plan transferring) **was CCI permitted** to move end-user accounts under **any section** of AT&T's Tariff FCC No. 2 without CCI transferring the plan. Also consider petitioners had Letter of Agency authority on all end-user locations to control and freely move the end user accounts without needing to notify them—however they were notified.
- 2) Decide at the time of the attempted Jan 13th 1995, CCI to PSE traffic only (i.e. locations only transfer without CCI's plan transferring) **was CCI prohibited** from moving accounts under section 2.1.8 **or any other section** of AT&T's Tariff FCC No. 2 without CCI transferring the plan. Also consider petitioners had Letter of Agency authority on all end-user locations to control and freely move the end user accounts without needing to notify them--however they were notified.
- 3) Decide the 15 day statute of limitations provision in section 2.1.8 as of Jan 13th 1995 as it related to the CCI to PSE traffic only transfer under AT&T's tariff No 2.
- 4) Decide whether AT&T's shutting down of section 2.1.8 to all traffic only transfers without the plan was an illegal remedy such that it prohibited petitioners from transferring less traffic to comply with AT&T's reliance upon the section 2.2.4 fraudulent use.
