Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 2, 2016, representatives of Time Warner Inc. ("TWX") and its subsidiary Home Box Office, Inc. ("HBO") met with staff of the Office of General Counsel in connection with the proceeding referenced above. The companies were represented by Paul Cappuccio, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of TWX; Carol Melton, Executive Vice President, Global Public Policy for TWX; Tom Woodbury, President of Global Distribution for HBO; and Eve Konstan, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of HBO. The FCC staff from the Office of General Counsel who attended the meeting were Jonathan Sallet, General Counsel, and Owen Kendler, counsel.

The purpose of this meeting was to update the FCC with additional information, including public statements made by Charter and nonpublic interactions with Charter that support the concern previously expressed by Time Warner and HBO at a meeting with the FCC staff in January 2016, that if the merger is approved, a combined Charter-Time Warner Cable-Bright House will attempt to harm the continued development of over-the-top video broadband competition. This included showing the FCC a video clip that had previously been telecast on CNBC on November 12, 2015.

Time Warner and HBO urged the Commission to take as much time as is necessary to investigate further these concerns and others raised by the proposed merger, and to ensure that Charter would not or could not harm over-the-top broadband competition.
