**MOTION
BY ENCANA OIL AND GAS (USA), INC.
TO WITHDRAW NOTICE OF APPEARANCE**

By its attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.41 of the Commission’s rules,¹ Encana Oil and Gas (USA), Inc. (“Encana”) hereby submits this Motion to Withdraw its Notice of Appearance filed in this proceeding on May 9, 2011.² By withdrawing its Notice of Appearance, Encana understands that the



captioned Assignment Applications from Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC (“MCLM”)³ to Encana will be dismissed with prejudice and Encana will be removed as a party to this proceeding.⁴

Upon approval of this Motion by the Presiding Judge, Encana will advise the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau that it no longer wishes to prosecute the Assignment Application and will instruct counsel for MCLM to withdraw it.⁵ Encana will confirm for the record when, according to ULS, MCLM has withdrawn the Assignment Application.
