Re: Notice of Ex Parte Communication: *Use of Spectrum Bands Above 24 GHz For Mobile Radio Services, et al.*, GN Docket No. 14-177, IB Docket No. 15-256, RM-11664, WT Docket No. 10-112, IB Docket No. 97-95; Amendment of Parts 0, 1, 2, 15 and 18 of the Commission's Rules Regarding Authorization of Radiofrequency Equipment, et al., ET Docket No. 15-170, RM-11673

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 4, 2016, Regina Dugan, Vice President, Advanced Technology and Projects Group; Johanna Shelton, Senior Policy Counsel; Tom Lue, Corporate Counsel; and I met with Chairman Wheeler and Edward Smith. In addition, Ms. Dugan and Mr. Lue were accompanied by George Ivanov, Public Policy & Government Relations Senior Analyst, and me for meetings with Commissioner Clyburn, Louis Peraertz, and Karl Gerner; Commissioner Rosenworcel and Johanna Thomas; and Commissioner Pai and Brendan Carr. Ms. Dugan, Mr. Lue, and Mr. Ivanov also met with Commissioner O'Rielly, Erin McGrath, and Amy Bender.

Consistent with our filings in the above-captioned proceedings, we urged the FCC to empower innovative uses in the high-frequency bands above 24 GHz as part of its flexible and balanced spectrum policy.¹ In particular, we urged the FCC to enable opportunities for unlicensed use of the 57-71 GHz band.² We reiterated our arguments that, given present characteristics of useful field disturbance sensors, heavy constraints on their use at 57-64 GHz are no longer appropriate.³ As such, the FCC should allow fixed and mobile field disturbance sensors to operate alongside other communications services between 57 and 71 GHz.⁴ We also supported FCC proposals to update modular certification procedures to keep pace with innovation and speed the
