Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 64.1120(e) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e), Broadsmart Florida, Inc. (Broadsmart Florida), by its counsel, respectfully notifies the Commission that Broadsmart Florida intends to acquire a portion of the customer base of its affiliate, North American Telecommunications Corporation d/b/a Broadsmart ("Broadsmart").¹ Broadsmart Florida is complying with the Commission's rules and procedures governing compliance with Section 258 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, including the provision of advance written notice to all affected customers. In conformity with Commission rules, Broadsmart Florida provides the following information:

Parties to the Transaction: The parties involved in the transaction are North American Telecommunications Corporation d/b/a Broadsmart (the Assignor) and Broadsmart Florida, Inc. (the Assignee).

Types of Telecommunications Services Provided to the Affected Subscribers: Broadsmart provides local exchange, long distance and international telephone services to the affected subscribers on a retail basis. Broadsmart Florida will provide the same services to these subscribers.

¹ Broadsmart Florida and Broadsmart are commonly-owned affiliates. The customer transfer discussed herein is being implemented as part of an internal reorganization of the Broadsmart companies.

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Date of Transfer of the Subscribers to Acquiring Carrier: Broadsmart intends to transfer the affected subscribers to Broadsmart Florida on April 7, 2016, or as soon thereafter as the necessary arrangements are in place.

Attached to this letter are (a) Broadsmart Florida's certification of compliance with the requirements of the Commission governing transfers of subscribers, and (b) a copy of the notice sent to the affected subscribers, as required under the rules.

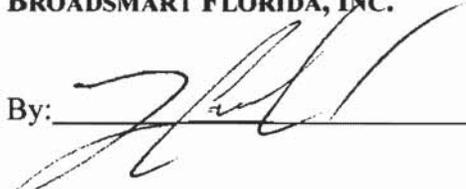

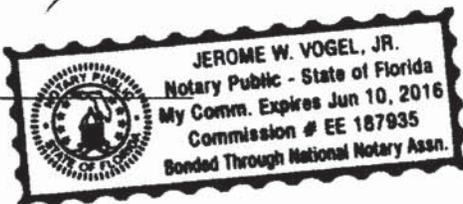

Sample Customer Notice

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING YOUR TRADITIONAL ANALOG TELEPHONE SERVICE

Dear Broadsmart Customer:

We are pleased to share with you that in a continuing effort to provide better service to our customers, North American Telecommunications Corporation d/b/a Broadsmart (Broadsmart) is undertaking an internal reorganization. As part of this, we will be transferring our traditional telephone operations into a separate Broadsmart company, Broadsmart Florida, Inc. (Broadsmart Florida). As a result of this transfer, your Broadsmart telephone service will be provided by Broadsmart Florida. Broadsmart Florida is owned and managed by the same team that currently provides your Broadsmart telephone services. Consequently, the transfer will have no adverse effect upon the quality of those services. The only change will be that a different Broadsmart entity will be your service provider. Because your traditional telephone services will be provided by a different Broadsmart entity, however, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Florida Public Service Commission require that we notify you of the change and of your rights in this regard.

First, no action on your part is required. Although you may choose another carrier for your traditional telephone service, we hope that you will continue as a Broadsmart Florida customer, and we look forward to the opportunity to continue providing you with quality telephone services.

Your telephone services will not be affected. You will continue to use your same telephone numbers, and you will not incur any fees in connection with the transfer of your service. As a Broadsmart Florida customer, you will continue to receive the same services at the same rates, terms and conditions as you currently receive. (Notice of any future changes in rates, terms and conditions of service will be provided to you as required by law.)

The effective date of the transfer will be on or shortly after April 7, 2016. At that time, Broadsmart Florida will become your service provider of telephone service. If you choose a telephone service provider other than Broadsmart Florida and you have a term contract with Broadsmart, you will still be responsible for any applicable early contract termination charges.

NOTE: If you have placed a "freeze" on your Broadsmart telephone services to prevent their unauthorized transfer to another carrier that will not hinder this transfer and the freeze protection will remain in force after the transfer to Broadsmart Florida. If you choose to move your analog telephone service to a new local service provider, you will need to contact your new provider to re-establish freeze protection for you after the transfer.

Our Broadsmart customer service operations will continue to provide customer support for your telephone service following the transfer. If you have any questions or concerns with respect to service needs, complaints or billing issues, either before or after the transfer, you may call 800-816-0898.
