Matanuska Telephone Association, Inc. (MTA), Study Area Code 613015 hereby notifies the Federal communications Commission (FCC) and the Wireline Competition Bureau (WCB) of changes that MTA has made to its December 31, 2014 and June 30, 2015 FCC Form 477's on March 9, 2016.

MTA with the help of sub-contractors and new reporting software functionality was able to identify and provide additional detail than the previously submitted FCC Form 477's provided. The previous submissions provided the requested information, but at a higher level. We are now able to get more detail. MTA found this during a review of the A-CAM Version 1.5 illustrative results of census blocks meeting a minimum of 10/1 broadband speeds.

Following an exhaustive review, MTA took action and submitted revised forms on March 9, 2016. MTA respectfully requests that the FCC allow these updates to be included in the forthcoming version of the A-CAM as soon as possible to reflect the accurate level of broadband availability in the area.
