As an ARRL member and member of the CWOps organization, I would like to add my support of RM-11759. The proposed adjustment of subbands on the 80 meter band would improve the balance and decrease interference between the various modes Amateur Radio operators use on that band. With the increase in digital mode popularity, and the unfortunate past over-reallocation of band space to voice modes by the FCC, the CW mode has increasingly been pressured into less and less exclusive band space on 80 meters. The proposed 50KHz reallocation provides a reasonable bandspace for each mode and accurately represents the popularity of each mode.

Again, I support RM-11759 and hope the FCC adopts the proposal to restore a proper balance between modes on the 80 meter band.
