Dear Secretary Dortch:

On March 10, 2016 BT Americas Inc. ("BT") met with Nick Degani from Commissioner Pai's office. Representing BT were Sheba Chacko, Senior Counsel and Head, Americas Regulation and Global Telecoms Policy, and Thomas Whitehead, Director, US Government Affairs. BT briefed Mr. Degani on the economic study that BT commissioned from WIK-Consult ("WIK study") which benchmarks international Ethernet services regulation and outcomes for consumers. BT had filed the study with its reply comments on February 19, 2016 in the special access docket WC Dkt. No. 05-25. During this meeting, BT also highlighted the inconsistencies in positions taken by Verizon and AT&T before regulators outside versus inside the US as noted in BT's ex parte filed February 29, 2016 in this same docket.
