In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on March 11, 2016, Susan Crandall of Intelsat, and Jennifer Hindin and Colleen King of Wiley Rein LLP and counsel for Intelsat, met with Nicholas Degani, legal advisor to Commissioner Ajit Pai.

In the meeting, Intelsat thanked the Commission for its efforts to reallocate regulatory fees to more accurately reflect the Commission's work on behalf of U.S.-licensed space station operators. The discussion then focused on further changes that could be made to regulatory fees. First, Intelsat supports an increase in earth station fees. Second, Intelsat discussed the collection of regulatory fees from non-U.S. satellite operators with U.S. market access, given the work done by the staff on matters pertaining to non-U.S. satellite operators and the competitive inequities perpetuated by the current fee structure.
