On March 11, 2016, Mary Henze, Linda Hood, and the undersigned of AT&T Services, Inc. met with Ryan Palmer, Jay Schwarz, and Jonathan Lechter of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the Second Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM), Order on Reconsideration, Second Report and Order and Memorandum Opinion and Order in the above referenced dockets.

The purpose of the meeting was to clarify the carrier's obligations in implementing the section of the June 2015 Order regarding the boundaries and definition of reservations in Oklahoma and determining eligibility for enhanced Tribal discounts for Lifeline.

We also discussed the impact of the proposed mobile voice phase down on legacy high cost wireless CETCs who are required to participate in Lifeline. We urged the Commission to ensure minimal, if any, impact on these legacy CETCs.
