**SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION**

Pursuant to Sections 63.71 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 63.71) and Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (47 U.S.C. § 214(a)), Lakeside Telephone Company, Inc. (the "Company") hereby files this application to discontinue the provision of certain operator services to customers that the Company serves in the State of Mississippi (the "Application"). In support of this Application, the following information is submitted:

**I. Information Required by Section 63.71(a)(1) - (4)**

**B. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance**

The Company will discontinue certain local operator services to its customers on or about May 15, 2016, or upon completion of all necessary federal and state regulatory approvals.

**C. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected**

Affected local exchange customers are in the Company's service area which consists of the following:

**D. Brief Description of the Types of Service Affected**

The Company provides local exchange services within its service area as described in paragraph I.C, above. The following Operator Services will be discontinued in the Company's service area:

Person to Person – That service where the person originating the call specifies to the Company operators a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile service point to be reached through a Mobile Telephone Service attendant, or particular PBX Service point, department, or office to be reached.

Collect Call – A billing arrangement by which the charge for a call may be reversed provided the charge is accepted at the called service point.

Third Number Billed Call – A billing arrangement by which an operator assisted call may be charged to an authorized service point other than the service point originating the call or the service point where the call is terminated.

Busy Line Verification – An operator service allowing the operator to confirm when a line is idle or in use.

Busy Line Interruption Service – An operator service allowing the operator to break into a conversation when a line is in use.

International Directory Assistance – A service that allows customers to obtain telephone numbers for international locations where such information is available.

Collect Calling; Person-to-Person Calling; Third Number Billed Calls; Busy Line Verification; Busy Line Interruption and International Directory Assistance are collectively referred to as the “Affected Services”. This discontinuance application is limited to the Affected Services.

## **II. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers**

Notices were sent to all of the Company’s local exchange customers via letter by U.S. Mail on March 15, 2016. Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is a sample copy of the Notice sent to the affected customers.

In addition, and as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, the Company has notified and submitted a copy of this Application concurrent with this filing to the Mississippi Public Service Commission, the Governor of Mississippi, and the Secretary of the Department of Defense.

## **III. Status of Carrier**

The Company is a small, rural incumbent local exchange carrier and considered a dominant carrier with respect to the services that it proposes to discontinue in the State of Mississippi.

## **IV. Circumstances of Discontinuance**

The Company’s discontinuance of the Affected Services was a business decision based

on a lack of customer demand for the service. During the last 12 months only twenty six (26) calls have been placed using the above mentioned services. Accordingly, the Company does not believe that its customers will be adversely affected by the Company's discontinuance of Affected Services.


**V. Certification**

## EXHIBIT A

### Notice of Discontinuance of Operator Services

This notice is to inform you that on or after May 15, 2016, Lakeside Telephone Company, Inc. (the "Company") will no longer be providing certain operator services within the State of Mississippi.

Specifically, the following Operator Services will be discontinued:

Person to Person – That service where the person originating the call specifies to the Company operators a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile service point to be reach through a Mobile Telephone Service attendant, or particular PBX Service point, department, or office to be reached.

Collect Call – A billing arrangement by which the charge for a call may be reversed provided the charge is accepted at the called service point.

Third Number Billed Call – A billing arrangement by which an operator assisted call may be charged to an authorized service point other than the service point originating the call or the service point where the call is terminated.

Busy Line Verification – An operator service allowing the operator to confirm when a line is idle or in use.

Busy Line Interruption Service – An operator service allowing the operator to break into a conversation when a line is in use.

International Directory Assistance – A service that allows customers to obtain telephone numbers for international locations where such information is available.

This discontinuance is limited to these listed operator services and will not affect the services you receive from the Company in any other way. Customers will continue to have access to the following operator services: operator dialing, handling sent-paid calls, handling emergency calls and providing rate quotes where available.

The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. You may file your comments electronically through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System using the docket number established in the Commission's public notice for this proceeding, or you may address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the Section 63.71 Application of Lakeside Telephone Company, Inc.. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company,


including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.


