In revision of my previous filing:

AM broadcast stations should only be in 'low power' from 9pm to 6am (local time). Additionally, stations should be able to stay on even during the 'low power' hours to be able to broadcast in cases of extreme weather to inform the public of the danger. When power goes out in rural areas from a storm event, the AM radio broadcast is the only reliable source for the public to stay abreast of the weather conditions.
