On behalf of QUALCOMM Incorporated ("Qualcomm"), this is to report that on Thursday, March 17, 2016, Gene Fong, Sumit Verma, Doug Knisely, Dean Brenner, and the undersigned had a conference call with the following FCC staff members to discuss matters relating to the above-referenced proceeding: Chris Helzer and Paul Powell (of the Wireless Bureau), and Rashmi Doshi (of the Office of Engineering and Technology Laboratory).

During the call, Qualcomm encouraged the FCC to provide the relief requested in Qualcomm's October 19, 2015, Comments on the Petition for Reconsideration that CTIA filed in this proceeding. Qualcomm also explained that it fully expects the mobile operations enabled by the Commission's regulations for the 3.5 GHz band will be time synchronized as are virtually all other TDD mobile operations.
