(“IPC Systems”) and Etrali North America, LLC (“Etrali NA”) (together, “Applicants”), by their attorneys, respectfully submit the enclosed Amended Application for approval, as necessary, for the indirect transfer of control of Etrali NA to IPC Systems, amending the application filed February 24, 2016 in the above-referenced docket (the “Application”).

Applicants hereby and in the Amended Application withdraw the request for *nunc pro tunc* treatment in the Application, and are concurrently filing for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to continue providing domestic service to customers during the pendency of the Amended Application.
