Recently, it has come to my attention that Floridians are suffering from high special access fees. There are two main service providers that are controlling America's broadband network. Their children have access to broadband at school, but when they come home they do not have access to do their homework. Family members struggle to find jobs because most companies only accept online applications and require employees to have broadband access away from the office.
