Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 11, 2015, the Commission issued a Public Notice seeking comment on the *Applications of Charter Communications, Inc., Time Warner Cable Inc., and Advance/Newhouse Partnership for Consent to Transfer Control of Licenses and Authorizations*.¹ In that Public Notice, the Commission specified that comments be submitted through the Commission's electronic comment filing system.² Through comments, reply comments, *ex parte* letters, and other submissions, the Commission has developed a substantial record in this proceeding.

In addition, over the past several months the Commissioners and staff have received a number of voicemails from members of the public expressing a view on the proceeding. In general, these voicemails were opposed to the merger and expressed concerns that the merger would harm competition, cause service quality to drop, and cause prices to rise.
