RE: Request for Review of Funding Commitment Decision Letter for funding Year 2015, issued January 27, 2016

I am submitting this letter of appeal regarding denial of E-rate FY 2015 funding request for denial of E-rate FY 2015 funding requests 2860813 and 2860918, on the grounds that, the FCC Form 470 cited does not define specific services or functions required by the applicant. The specific services or functions required by the applicant were defined in Block 2 of the submitted Form 470 to USAC.

Appeal Reason	FCDL dated October 16, 2015 denied FRNs for not defining the specific services or functions required by the specific services or functions required.

The Schools and Library Decision funding commitment decision explanation states: This FRN is denied because the FCC Form 470 cited does not define the specific services or functions required by the applicant. The FCC Form 470

must clearly define the specific services or functions required by the applicant, including quantity and/or capacity for which funding will be sought when the FCC Form 470 is filed.

The denial of funding was based on the apparent lack of definition of specific services or functions requested, but when reviewing Block 2 of the FCC Form 470 services requested for category 1 and category 2 were included according to **DA 14-1556**. We are enclosing a copy of both FRNs 2860813 and 2860918. In addition, we are enclosing a table with the services for category 1 and 2. These services were included in FCC 470 based in the needs assessment done by Mr. Alexis Crespo-Cardona, Head of the Technological System, in order to comply with the **E- Rate Modernization Order**¹. Therefore, we request FRN 2860813 and 2860918 be funded and USAC actions remain consistent with this order.

Given that the denial of funding in this case was based on the apparent lack of definition of specific services or functions requested, we respectfully request that the SLD process this Letter of Appeal and approve the funding commitment for Biblioteca Publica Eduardo Negrón Benítez FRNs 2860813 and 2860918. The denial of funding for the apparent lack of definition of specific services or functions requested places a particular hardship on the Biblioteca Publica Eduardo Negrón Benítez that otherwise should have been approved for and received E-rate funding for its application. During 2013 the library served 18,789 persons and 23,056 were served during 2014². There was an increase of 23% visitors. The library serves students from 20 public schools³ and low- income population, which according to the ACS 5 yr Income & Moderate Income Summary Data is 55.91% in San Sebastián⁴.

We respectfully request that you overturn the denial and restore full funding of these FRNs. Thank you for reviewing this appeal. Please use the contact information below.





INFORME ANUAL 2014

Como supervisora de la Biblioteca Eduardo Negón Benítez, nos sentimos sumamente satisfechos al analizar los datos estadísticos sobre los servicios prestados y la asistencia de usuarios de San Sebastián y municipios adyacentes.


Nuestros archivos reflejan que en el 2013 visitaron nuestras instalaciones, 18,789 usuarios, mientras que en el 2014 la visitaron **23,056**. Esto refleja un aumento de 4,267 visitantes para un incremento de 23%. Por otro lado contamos con los siguientes hallazgos: La hora **más** concurrida fue las 3:00 p.m.; la menos concurrida fue las 7:00 p.m.; el mes **más** visitado fue el de octubre y el menos concurrido fue el de junio. El día **más** concurrido fue jueves mientras que el menos concurrido fue **sábado**.

Los dos hallazgos **más** significativos son los siguientes: el incremento general de visitantes en un 23% y la poca asistencia en el horario de las 7:00 a 8:00 p.m. En ese horario solo nos visitaron 232 personas durante todo el año, lo que significa un 1% del total de visitantes.

Estos datos estadísticos son de suma importancia para una mejor administración optimizando los recursos disponibles en beneficio del servicio comunitario que prestamos.
