UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Transferee/Assignee Nexstar Broadcasting Group, Inc. and Transferor/Assignor Media General, Inc. (“Applicants”), by their attorneys, hereby request an extension of time through and including April 14, 2016 to oppose: (1) the “Petition to Deny” filed by Communications Workers of America, Free Press, Common Cause, Public Knowledge, and the Open Technology Institute at New America (OTI); (2) the “Petition for Conditions” filed by Cox Communications, Inc.; and (3) the “Petition to Deny or Impose Conditions of DISH Network L.L.C., the American Cable Association, and ITTA” (collectively, the “Petitions”). *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.46.

The Petitions were filed with the Commission on March 18, 2016 and first appeared in the docket of this proceeding on the afternoon of March 21, 2016. Under Sections 1.45 and 1.4(h) of the Commission’s Rules, oppositions would be due on March 31, 2016. The Applicants request a two-week extension of that deadline in order to fully review and respond to the assertions contained in the Petitions given the proximity of the current deadline to the March 29, 2016 initial commitment deadline for the broadcast television incentive auction. Accordingly, good cause exists for granting this request as it will enable Applicants to submit a

comprehensive and accurate filing, ensuring that the Commission has a complete record to aid its decision making process. Applicants submit that there will be no prejudice to any party as a result of this brief extension, and counsel appearing on each of the Petitions has authorized Applicants to represent that the petitioners do not object to this request.

Accordingly, Applicants hereby request that the time for opposing the Petitions be extended until and including April 14, 2016.
