Dear Ms. Dortch,

On Friday, March 25, Daryl Hunter, Senior Director, Regulatory Affairs and Chris Murphy, Associate General Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, of ViaSat, Inc. met telephonically with the following staff of the International Bureau, Bob Nelson, Chief Engineer, Jose Albuquerque, Division Chief, and Chip Fleming, Chief Division Engineer.

During the discussion, we reviewed ViaSat's current and future state-of-the art, high-capacity broadband networks and Spectrum Frontiers proceeding comments and analysis, as reflected in recently filed comments and reply comments in the above proceedings. We also elaborated on a presentation previously made by Mark Dankberg, Chairman and CEO of ViaSat, Inc. on March 15, 2016.

We explained that ViaSat is engaged in a constructive information sharing process with other members of the satellite and terrestrial wireless industries to exchange information on various parties current and future networks' technical parameters and operating requirements in the bands under consideration in the proceeding, particularly the 28 and 37.5-40 GHz bands. We also discussed possible technical issues associated with ViaSat's current and future broadband networks and potential sharing issues. In particular, we emphasized that ViaSat will need to be able to deploy satellite internet access points in urban areas and expressed concerns about various high power terrestrial mobile concepts being discussed in the record that will require careful study in order to ensure protection of current and future satellite broadband networks. We explained that we have been encouraged by the technical exchange and that more technical meetings are planned to continue the positive dialogue.
