UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The undersigned parties, all petitioners in the above-captioned proceeding (“Petitioners”), hereby request an extension of time through and including May 5, 2016 to file replies to any opposition(s) that may be filed regarding the above-referenced transfer and assignment applications. Nexstar Broadcasting Group, Inc. and Transferor/Assignor Media General, Inc. (the “Applicants”) have already filed a request for extension of time to April 14, 2016 to file oppositions.¹ Assuming the Commission grants that request, then under Sections 1.45 and 1.4(h) of the Commission’s rules, replies would be due on April 21, 2016.

The Petitioners request a two-week extension of that deadline in order to fully review and respond to any arguments the Applicants might raise in their oppositions. For large, complex transactions such as this one, the Commission routinely sets pleading cycles that allow interested

parties additional time over the default timelines in the Commission's rules. This helps ensure that the public has adequate time to review and respond to pleadings in a meaningful way and to build a record for the Commission to reach an informed decision.

Petitioners submit that there will be no prejudice to any party as a result of the requested short extension, and counsel representing the Applicants have authorized Petitioners to represent that the Applicants do not object to this request.

Accordingly, Petitioners hereby request that the time for replies be extended until and including May 5, 2016.
